#### **MISSION STATEMENT**

The Mission of the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) of Sheboygan County is to empower and support seniors, people with disabilities, and their families to ask for help, find a way to live with dignity and security, and achieve maximum independence and quality of life.

#### **Aging & Disability Resource Center**

Aging & Disability Resource Centers shall serve all of the following groups of individuals, including people who inquire about or request assistance on behalf of members of these groups, regardless of their financial means:

- Elderly (aged 60 and older)
- Adults with developmental disabilities
- Adults with physical disabilities
- Adults with mental illness and/or substance use disorders
- Adult is 18 years of age and older.

The core services provided by an Aging & Disability Resource Center include:

- <u>Information and Assistance</u>: The Resource Center maintains a resource file of services and programs available to adults over age 60 and adults with disabilities in Sheboygan County. Individuals may call or stop in Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to receive assistance.
- Long Term Care Options Counseling: The Resource Center has professionals who can provide confidential assistance with or information about care needs and options available. The consultation is available at no charge and will review both public and private options.
- Benefits Counseling: The Resource Center has Benefit Specialists who share information about programs available to seniors and individuals with disabilities. The Elderly Benefit Specialist (EBS) provides information and assistance to seniors age 60 and over and the Disability Benefit Specialist (DBS) provides information and assistance to adults age 18 through 59. Some examples include Medicare, Medicare Part D, Medicare Savings Plans, Medicaid, the Medicaid Purchase Plan (MAPP), and Homestead Tax Credit. Benefit Specialists may assist with appealing denials for Social Security and Medical Assistance benefits. Seniors age 65 may also receive assistance to apply for Senior Care.

### **Aging & Disability Resource Center - continued**

- <u>Transitional Services</u>: The Resource Center shall invite referrals and coordinate with existing support systems to assist young adults with disabilities to transition to the adult long-term care system. The Resource Center shall share information about services available with school districts and other children's long-term support systems.
- Prevention and Early Intervention Services: The Resource Center shall collaborate with other community resources to promote efforts to keep individuals healthy and independent. This includes providing information, support, and assistance to family and other informal caregivers to delay or prevent the need for comprehensive long-term care services.
- Access to Publicly Funded Long-Term Care Programs and Services: The Resource Center shall assure that individuals who make contact or are referred are informed about and screened for eligibility for Long-Term Care Funding for services. The Aging & Disability Resource Center shall have a written procedure for ensuring an efficient and timely access to public long-term benefits.
- Other Services: Adult Protective Services staff located at the Aging & Disability Resource Center are available to address concerns of abuse and self-neglect of elders and vulnerable adults. Concerns and referrals may be made by contacting the Aging & Disability Resource Center staff. Calls are kept confidential, and Adult Protective Services staff investigate the situation and provide follow up as required.

Information about other elder services, such as volunteer transportation, chore service, reassurance calls, peer friends, dining sites, nutrition, and recreation may be obtained by contacting the Aging & Disability Resource Center.

#### **Adult Day Care Services**

Adult Day Care Centers provide supervised and structured programming that includes a variety of health, social, and support services in a protective setting during daytime hours. This is a community-based service model designed to meet the individual needs of people with functional impairments and/or Alzheimer's or other dementias.

Is transportation provided?

- What is the cost?
- What medical conditions/disabilities are accepted?
- Are there a variety of activities and choice of individual and group participation?
- Is the menu balanced and are there choices?
- Can trial visits be arranged?

#### **Advanced Directive**

An Advanced Directive is a legal document that allows individuals to put in writing their wishes about their health care in case they are no longer able to communicate their wishes in the future. A Living Will/Declaration to Physicians and a Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care are both Advanced Directives. To find the Advanced Directive that is suitable for you or your loved one, contact your family physician, local hospital, or your family attorney, or obtain copies of forms online at <a href="https://www.dhfs.state.wi.us">www.dhfs.state.wi.us</a>. A copy of the completed Advanced Directive form should be kept with the physician and the hospital of choice.

#### **Living Will/Declaration to Physicians:**

The Living Will/Declaration to Physicians is an Advanced Directive. The Living Will allows the individual to state his/her wishes regarding health care in the event of a terminal illness and/or the end of life or a persistent vegetative state. The decisions the individual makes will be carried out as stated in the living will regardless of whether any other family member has a different wish.

#### **Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care:**

The Power of Attorney for Health Care form is an Advanced Directive. It allows the individual to appoint another person(s) to make health care decisions if he/she becomes unable to make these decisions. The person(s) appointed is the Health Care Agent. It is important to discuss end-of-life wishes with the Health Care Agent so that they are able to carry out wishes. This document gives the Health Care Agent authority to make decisions only when <u>activated</u> (when the individual has been determined incapable to make health care decisions by two physicians). It does not give your Health Care Agent any other authority for your financial or other business decisions.

#### **Pre-Hospital Do Not Resuscitate Bracelet:**

This is a **Do Not Resuscitate (DNR)** order issued by a physician to direct emergency medical technicians, first responders, and emergency health care facilities not to attempt cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on a person for whom the order is issued if that person suffers cardiac or respiratory arrest.

#### **Types of Funerals**

#### **Traditional Funeral**

Visitation, service, entombed or interred remains.

#### **Modified Traditional Funeral:**

Abbreviated aspects of the funeral according to personal family preferences.

#### **Direct Disposition:**

No visitation or funeral services are held with the body present. A memorial service can be held instead.

#### **Home Health Agency (Skilled Home Care)**

Medical home health agencies provide services that include skilled nursing, physical/speech/occupational therapy, wound care, and IV management. A medical home health agency is licensed and required to meet State of Wisconsin standards. The Medicare and/or Medicaid Programs, or private insurance, may reimburse medical home health agency costs.

- Does the nurse come at scheduled times?
- Are the services required covered by Medicare or Medicaid?
- Can the agency provide 24-hour coverage?
- What types of service does the agency provide?
- Does the agency conduct a background check on all employees?

#### **Non-Medical Home Care**

Non-medical in-home agencies may offer a variety of services designed to assist a client to remain in his or her home. These agencies are not licensed as home health agencies by the State of Wisconsin and are not authorized to provide skilled care. They are, however, authorized to provide personal care, homemaker, and companionship services.

#### Homemaker/Companionship Services:

Homemaker services generally can include meal preparation, shopping, bed making, laundry, general housecleaning, simple household repair (replace burned-out light bulb), personal assistance, running errands.

#### **Personal Care Services:**

Personal care services generally consist of assistance with the following activities of daily living: grooming, bathing, dressing, personal hygiene, exercising, transferring, ambulation, adaptive equipment, supervision and support, monitoring and supervision for permanent risk, and assistance with medications.

#### **Companion Services:**

Companionship services generally consist of providing supervision and minimal assistance to someone and often are used for respite when the main caregiver is out of the home.

- Are all employees insured and bonded?
- Does the agency conduct a background check on all employees?
- Who is responsible for providing back-up if a caregiver cannot cover a shift or does not show up?
- How are the caregivers supervised?
- Are all caregivers employees of the agency?

### **Personal Emergency Response Systems**

Personal emergency response systems are 24-hour electronic monitoring systems that allow a person to contact help in time of need. The basic system consists of a button, often located on a pendant or wristband that sends a signal to a device connected to the telephone. When the button is pushed, the device calls a response center, which in turn, contacts someone that the senior has identified as an emergency responder. If the response center is not able to contact a responder, a rescue unit is contacted to go to the person's home. Some personal emergency response systems also have medication dispensers connected to them that remind an individual to take his/her medication. The dispenser can be used as a stand-alone unit or along with a personal emergency response system.

# Personal Emergency Response Systems

### Questions to Ask...

- What is the cost of the service?
- What features are available? Wellness checks, medication monitoring?
- Who answers the call?
- What happens if the button is pushed by mistake?

Assisted living is a generic term that includes Community Based Residential Facilities (CBRFs) and Residential Care Apartment Complexes (RCACs). CBRFs are state licensed group homes for five or more unrelated adults that provide care and supervision in a home-like environment.

Residential Care Apartment Complexes (RCACs) are registered with the State and consist of separate apartments with kitchen, bathroom and living areas. The apartments can range from an efficiency-style apartment to a full-scale two-bedroom or more apartment.

### Questions to Ask...

- How do residents pay for their care and services?
- What services are provided and is there an extra fee for these services above room and board?
- Does the facility accommodate special diet orders?
- Does the facility accept residents with specific needs for incontinence or insulin injections?
- Does the facility have a copy of its most recent review by the Bureau of Quality Assurance?
- Does the facility have safety devices or alarms on the doors to the outside?

The Alzheimer's Association of Southeastern Wisconsin sent a Memory Care survey to define the level of care for persons with dementia to all Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing facilities. If you are seeking a residential placement for someone with Alzheimer's Disease or other related dementia, you may find results from facilities that completed and returned the survey by contacting the Alzheimer's Association at 1-800-272-3900.
