

Sheboygan County Lake Public Access Fees

In 2011, the Sheboygan County Board implemented a fee system for the six lake public access areas it maintains. The fees collected go into a segregated, non-lapsing account for projects and maintenance specifically affiliated with the public access areas. The six public access areas are: Big Elkhart Lake, Little Elkhart Lake, Sheboygan Marsh, Gerber Lake, Jetzer's Lake, and Crystal Lake.

Fees are required year-round unless you are patronizing the Sheboygan Marsh Park Restaurant, attending an event sponsored by the Sheboygan Marsh Park Restaurant, fishing along the Marsh shoreline, using the Marsh Observation Tower, fishing from any fishing piers or shoreline, picnicking at any boat launches for noncommercial purposes, or any other purpose other than parking or using a boat launch facility for launching.

Passes can be obtained at any of the landings, by visiting the [Planning & Conservation](#) office, or at various vendors throughout the County.

Passes are good **April through April** to coincide with WDNR fishing licensing.
