A pre-stamped, addressed envelope to return donations to the Aging and Disability Resource Center will be presented at the end of your appointment along with the estimated mileage. The estimated mileage may be used to gauge the amount of the donation. All donations are appreciated. Individuals will not be denied services due to lack of funds.
