SHEBOYGAN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 20 (2017/18)

Re: Amending Land Records Modernization Plan

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 59.72 provides that counties may establish a land information office or may direct that the functions and duties of a land information office may be undertaken by an existing board or office, and

WHEREAS, one of the responsibilities of a land information office is to prepare a land information modernization plan for the county and obtain compliance with Wis. Stat. § 16.967 in order to obtain land record modernization funding, and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan County Board, through the adoption of Resolution No. 15 (1990/91), established a Land Records Board which, through the adoption of Ordinance No. 1 (2010/11) is now called the Land Records Council and which is charged with maintaining and revising a Land Records Modification Plan for the County, and

WHEREAS, the Land Records Council proposed an updated Sheboygan County Land Records Modification Plan which was approved by the County Board by the adoption of Resolution No. 1 (2016/17), and

WHEREAS, the Land Records Council has proposed an amendment to the Modernization Plan through the addition of a new Section 4, as filed in the office of the County Clerk, which the Finance Committee believes to be in the best interest of Sheboygan County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheboygan County Land Records Modernization Plan be amended through the addition of a new Section 4, as filed with the County Clerk.
