

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13 (2017/18)

Re: **Establishing Speed Zones on County Roads "W" and "TA"**  
**(Towns of Lima and Sheboygan Respectively)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.11, in the interest of safety, the Transportation Committee recommends that to maintain reasonable and safe speed zones, the present speed zones on a portion of County Roads "W" in the Town of Lima and "TA" in the Town of Sheboygan be reduced as hereinafter specified.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Changing Speed Zone.** The provisions of Sections 20.03(4) and (10) of the County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended to read as follows (redlining indicates additions, strikeouts indicate deletions)(only those sections affected appear):

20.03(4) TOWN OF LIMA

(a) County Road "W"

1. Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Road "I" in the unincorporated place known as Hingham, easterly for a distance of ~~4,815~~2,700 feet.
2. Forty-five miles per hour from a point ~~4,815~~2,700 feet east of County Road "I" to Camp Riverside Road.

20.03(10) TOWN OF SHEBOYGAN

- (g) County Road "TA" – ~~Forty-five~~Thirty-five miles per hour from the intersection at Erie Avenue south to its intersection at Union Avenue.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the County Board, approval of the Department of Transportation, publication, and installation of appropriate signage.
