SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. <u>03</u> (2018/19)

Re: Amending Sections 6.01 and 6.02 of the County Code to Update Membership and Officers of the Land Information Council

WHEREAS, the Land Information Council provides a valuable service to the citizens of Sheboygan County and serves in an advisory capacity to the Finance Committee of the County Board, and

WHEREAS, the composition of the Land Information Council needs to be updated to reflect the current County departmental structure and to provide flexibility to the Council members, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Sheboygan County to make the modifications to the Land Information Council Ordinance as set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Updating Sections 6.01 and 6.02</u>. Sections 6.01 and 6.02 of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (deletions indicated by strikeouts, additions by shading):

- 6.01 COUNTY LAND INFORMATION COUNCIL. In accordance with Wis. Stat. §§ 16.967 and 59.72, there is created a County Land Information Council consisting of the following members:
 - (1) The County Surveyor/Engineer.
 - (2) The Register of Deeds or designee
 - (3) The County Treasurer or designee
 - (4) The Planning Director or designee
 - (5) The County ConservationistCounty Information Technology Director or designee
 - (6) The County Finance and Information Technology Directoror designee
 - (7) The Emergency Management Director
 - (8) A realtor or member of the Sheboygan County Realtor's Association as appointed by the County Administrator
 - (9) A public safety or emergency communications representative employed within Sheboygan County as appointed by the County Administrator
 - (10) A County Supervisor as appointed by the County Board Chairperson
- 6.02 OFFICERS. The County Surveyor/Engineer is designated asCouncil shall appoint the County Land Information Officer (LIO) for purposes of compliance with Wis. Stat. § 59.72(3) and said appointee shall serve as Chairperson of the Council. The members shall periodically select such officers from their membership as may be necessary to conclude the

business of the Council. The LIO shall serve for three years ending in early January of the year preceding the effective date of each new three- (3-) year Land Information Modernization Plan).

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
