Re: Approving Use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds (No. 2)

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law, and

WHEREAS, ARPA established the coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program to provide \$350 Billion of support to state, territorial, local, and tribal governments in responding to the economic and public health impacts of COVID-19, and

WHEREAS, SLFRF funds may be used to provide assistance to households, businesses, and individuals within the eligible use categories described in the U.S. Department of Treasury's Interim Final Rule (Final Rule Pending), and

WHEREAS, the Interim Final Rule allows SLFRF funds to be used for four (4) categories:

- 1. to respond to the COVID-19 public health emergency or its negative economic impacts;
- 2. to respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 pandemic through premium pay or grants to employers;
- 3. for loss of revenue in the provision of government services due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- 4. to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure,

and

WHEREAS, Sheboygan County is eligible to receive \$22,403,443.00 in ARPA SLFRF funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheboygan County Board of Supervisors has determined that a portion of Sheboygan County's ARPA SLFRF funds shall be used for the following eligible expenses:
