NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Board Chair is authorized to send correspondence to entities engaged in selling, renting, or financing housing, encouraging them to adhere fully to the Fair Housing Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Sheboygan County Clerk is authorized and directed to place a fair housing poster or provide fair housing information at an appropriate public place and through this publication the County Board Chair shall cause owners of real estate, builders, developers, and mortgage lenders to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under the Federal Fair Housing legislation, and all other applicable state or local laws or ordinances.
