

A Sheboygan County Mental Health Crisis Services Roadmap Are you trying to determine if your loved one needs mobile crisis services?

Mobile Crisis is a 24/7, over-the-phone or mobile crisis service that includes emergency crisis counseling and safety assessments.

Use this decision map to help determine the appropriate options for your loved one.



Law Enforcement may be able to help:
920-459-3333 (Non-Emergency) or 9-1-1

If you call 911 for a mental health emergency, ask for an officer that has completed

Crisis Intervention Training (CIT).

These officers have had additional training in working through crisis situations.

Suicide and Crisis Lifeline: 988

Providing 24/7, free and confidential support to people in suicidal or emotional distress works.

If, after further assessment, it is determined that there is nothing Mobile Crisis Services can do, a series of follow-up calls will be conducted for one week unless the individual refuses or warrants a welfare check/call.
