# FAQ:

Q: Why do I need a healthcare provider?

A: Having a healthcare provider leads to lower bills cost, earlier health issue detection, and better coordinated care.

Some services they provide:

- Routine screenings
- Immunizations
- Lab work
- Checkups
- Physicals

Q: What if I have insurance but they do not cover certain expenses, such as medications or a wheelchair?

A: You will be liable to pay up to a set dollar amount every year for anything that insurance does not cover. This would be labeled as the 'out of pocket' costs in your insurance plan. Typically around \$15,000/year.

Q: What if I want to see a specific medical professional but I am not sure whether or not they are in network?

A: You can ask the medical professional themselves which insurance providers they accept or you call your insurance company to ask whether that specific medical professional is in network.

# GETTING HEALTH CARE



### **DEFINITIONS:**

#### **NETWORK**

The facilities providers and suppliers your health insurer or plan has contracted with to provide health care services.

#### **PREMIUM**

The amount you pay for your health insurance/plan every month.

#### **Out of Pocket**

Your expenses for medical care that are not reimbursed by insurance.

#### Co-Pay

An amount you pay as your share of the cost for a medical service or item.

#### **Deductable**

The amount you owe for covered health care services before your health insurance/plan begins to pay.

# High vs Low Deductable

Often plans with lower monthly premiums have higher deductibles and vice versa.
