

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 08 (2023/24)

Re: **Repealing and Re-creating Chapter 70 – Sanitary Regulations**

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan County Sanitary Ordinance promotes and protects public health and safety by assuring the proper siting, design, installation, inspection, management, and maintenance of private sewage systems; and

WHEREAS, the County Board has authority to adopt sanitary regulations pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 59.70(1), 59.70(5), 145.04, 145.19, 145.20, and 145.01(4m)(a) through (e); and

WHEREAS, Sheboygan County staff has reviewed Sheboygan County Code Chapter 70-Sanitary Regulations and has updated the same to reflect changes to terminology, practices and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Planning, Resources, Agriculture, and Extension Committee, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.69(5)(e), held a public hearing regarding the proposed changes to the County's Sanitary Ordinance on October 10, 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Repealing and Re-creating Chapter 70.** Chapter 70 of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and re-created as attached hereto.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and upon approval as may be required from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
