SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 14 (2023/24)

Re: Creating an Oversight Committee to Advise Sheboygan County in Administering and Evaluating the Treatment Alternatives and Diversion Program (TAD)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §165.95, the Wisconsin legislature created the alternatives to incarceration grant program to allow Counties to establish and operate programs including suspended and deferred prosecution programs and programs based on principles of restorative justice, that provide alternatives to prosecution and incarceration for criminal offenders who abuse alcohol or other drugs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §165.95(5)(a), a County that receives such a grant shall create an oversight committee to advise the County in administering and evaluating its alternatives to incarceration program; and

WHEREAS, Sheboygan County, as a grant recipient under Wis. Stat. §165.95, wishes to create an oversight committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

- Section 1. <u>Creating Code</u>. Section 10.09 of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby created as follows:
- 10.09 Oversight Committee *to advise Sheboygan County in Administering and Evaluating the Treatment Alternatives Diversion Program/Grant (TAD)
 - (1) The Oversight Committee shall consist of 10 members, including:
 - (a) A Circuit Court Judge.
 - (b) The District Attorney or his or her Designee.
 - (c) The State Public Defender or his or her Designee.
 - (d) A local Law Enforcement Official.
 - (e) A Representative of the County.
 - (f) Representative of the Sheboygan County Health and Human Services Department.
 - (g) A Representative of the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections.
 - (h) A Representative from a Private Social Services Agency.
 - (i) Two (2) Representatives of a Substance Abuse Treatment Provider.

^{*}Members of the Oversight Committee shall be appointed by the County Administrator and serve on the Committee until such time as they no longer occupy the position for which they were appointed.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
