American Rescue Plan Act

(Enacted March 11, 2021)

• National: \$1.9 Trillion

• Wisconsin: \$2.5 Billion

• Sheboygan County: \$22.4 Million

• City of Sheboygan: \$22 Million

• Total Local Allocation: \$51.4 Million

- Deadline to obligate the funds is: December 2024 & expended by December 2026
 - Sheboygan County received the first half of our allocation (\$11,201,721) on 05/19/2021
 - Sheboygan County received the second half of our allocation (\$11,207,721) on 06/09/2022


