How to Search our TRACT

Our computerized tract begins July 19, 1996 as document number 1455865 Volume 1456 Page 797

Prior to July 19, 1996 use our Tract and Abstract Books

Unplatted Tract Books

Abstracts - Enter into the document # field: example **AB-T13R20-S01-1** AB = abstract book, T13 = town, R20 = range, S01 = section, 1 = book number

Note: the townships can have several book numbers ranging from 1 to 4, number one being the oldest of the records

B series tract books - Enter into the document # field **B-T13R21-S01** T= town, R = range, S = section

C series tract books - Enter into the document # field **C-T14R23-S10** T= town, R = range, S = section

Subdivision Tract Books –

First, you will need to find which tract book your subdivision is in. Search in the document # field INDEXSUBD- and the first letter of the name of the subdivision. For example: Taylors Addition search INDEXSUBD-T in the doc # field. Use this chart to find which tract or abstract book you need.

Taylors Addition is found in B6 on page 74. Now you can search the tract book by keying in B-06 in the doc # field. Then go to page 74 and here is your tract index.

You may use the "go to option to jump to a certain page.

If you need to go farther back then look on the chart and find the abstract volume you need. Key it into the document number field. Examples AB-A, AB-B, AB-1, etc. You will get the whole abstract book.
