## SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. <u>08</u> (2024/25)

Re: Amending Sections of Chapter 96 related to Medical Examiner Fees

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.36, the County Board is responsible for setting fees rendered by the medical examiner; and

**WHEREAS**, in Chapter 2 of the County Code, the County Board of Supervisors delegated fee setting under Wis. Stat. § 59.36 to the Law Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of such delegation, it is appropriate to amend Chapter 96 as it relates to such fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

- Section 1. <u>Amending Medical Examiner's Fees</u>. Sections 96.10, 96.11, 96.12 and 96.13 of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended as follows (additions indicated by shading; deletions by strikeouts):
- 96.10 CERTIFICATIONS OF DEATH. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 59.36, 59.365 and 69.18(2)(d)3, except for a medical certification for the cause of death of an indigent, the fee charged by the Medical Examiner for providing a medical certification of death shall be One Hundred Sixteen and 57/100 (\$116.57) as established and amended by the Law Committee.
- 96.11 CREMATION PERMITS. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 59.36, 59.365 and 979.10, the fee charged by the Medical Examiner for each cremation permit issued shall be One Hundred Seventy-four and 86/100 (\$174.86) as established and amended by the Law Committee.
- 96.12 DISINTERMENT FEE. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 59.36 and 59.365, the fee charged by the Medical Examiner for each disinterment shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as established and amended by the Law Committee.
- 96.13 TRANSPORT CHARGES. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.36 and 59.365, the charge assessed by the Medical Examiner for transporting a deceased person from a death scene to a County morgue or a holding facility shall be Two Hundred Thirty four and 40/100 (\$234.40) as established and amended by the law Committee, plus any actual out-of-pocket expenses for transport pouches or similar disposable items.

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Section 2. **Effective Date**. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
