

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 04 (2010/11)

Re: **Modifying Prisoner Board Fee for Home Detention Program**

**Printed as amended*

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 302.372, counties are authorized to enact ordinances for charging of prisoners for the cost of maintaining them in correctional facilities, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, the Sheboygan County Board enacted Chapter 52 of the Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, Section 52.03(2) provides that the charges for participation in the home detention program are Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per day, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has determined that the costs associated with monitoring the home detention are less than Thirty Dollars (\$30.00), and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff believes that by reducing the fee from Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) to the actual cost of the program, it would allow more people to be able to participate in the home detention program and would ultimately yield greater revenues to the County and less expense to the County since fewer correctional beds will be utilized;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Modifying Section 52.03(2)**. Section 52.03(2) of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (strikeouts indicate deletions; redlining indicates additions):

- (2) For a person in a home detention program pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 302.425, a sum as determined by the **Law Committee* reflecting the individual cost of administering the home detention program, but not to exceed the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per day, together with a processing fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each period of confinement.
