

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 10 (2012/13)

Re: **Repealing and Re-creating Chapter 72 – Shoreland Ordinance**

WHEREAS, Sheboygan County is required to revise certain portions of its Shoreland Ordinance to comply with statutory and administrative code requirements, and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Conservation Department has been working with the Department of Natural Resources, together with a "stakeholder" group to come into compliance with the statutory and administrative requirements while at the same time balancing private property rights against the public intent in controlling the use of shorelands and wetlands, and

WHEREAS, the Planning, Resources, Agriculture, and Extension Committee, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.69(5)(e), held a public hearing regarding the proposed changes to the County's Shoreland Ordinance on October 4, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Amending Code**. Chapter 72 of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and re-created as attached hereto.

Section 2. **Effective Date**. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and upon approval as may be required from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
