

**SHEBOYGAN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 18 (2012/13)**

**Re: Entering into Agreement with the City of Sheboygan for Administration of New Multipurpose Trail**

**WHEREAS**, through the adoption of Resolution No. 7 (2011/2012) on July 19, 2011, the Sheboygan County Board committed to the acquisition of a 1.7-mile portion of the former Union Pacific rail line through the City of Sheboygan for development of a multipurpose recreational trail, and

**WHEREAS**, under the general terms underlying the County's grant award from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) and other funding for the purchase, the County would develop, administer, and maintain the trail in concert with the City of Sheboygan which would provide day-to-day maintenance of the trail, and

**WHEREAS**, the County is about to purchase the trail property and begin development using the CMAQ funding and other funds, and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to reduce the division of labor agreement between the City and the County from an oral understanding to a formal intergovernmental cooperative agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheboygan County Board authorizes and directs the Planning Director and County Administrator to negotiate and to sign *\*the Multipurpose Trail Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the City of Sheboygan, a copy of which is on file with the County Clerk.*
