## SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. <u>08</u> (2014/15)

## Re: Amending Order of Business – Rules of Board

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, the County Board honors the lives or the careers of County Supervisors, other County officers and employees, or other community contributors or makes similar public recognition through Memorial Resolutions, and

**WHEREAS**, such Resolutions do not get referred to decision committees for action or debate like other Resolutions do, and

**WHEREAS**, persons interested in the memorial Resolutions should not be required to sit through unrelated Board activity until the memorial Resolution is introduced toward the end of the meeting;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Amending Order of Business</u>. Section 2.04(2) of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (additions indicated by redlining; deletions by strikeouts):

- (2) The order of business for all other meetings except the budget review session, special sessions, and the Organizational Meeting shall be as follows:
  - (a) Call to order.
  - (b) Certification of compliance with Open Meeting Law.
  - (c) Pledge of Allegiance.
  - (d) Roll call.
  - (e) Approval of Journal.
  - (f) Committee and other appointments.
  - (g) Presentations.
  - (h) Public Addresses to the Board.
  - (i) Letters, Communications, and Announcements.
  - (j) County Administrator's report.
  - (k) Public Hearings.
  - (I) Introduction of memorial Resolutions, not requiring Committee referral and action thereon.
  - (Im) Reports of Committees on referrals of Resolutions and Ordinances and action thereon in the following order:
    - 1. Executive Committee.
    - 2. Other standing committees in alphabetical order.
    - Special committees.
  - (mn) Elections.
  - (no) Other Committee reports and action thereon, if any.
  - (ep) Introduction of Resolutions, discussion, and action thereon. (All new Resolutions referred to Committees shall be read, titles only.)

- (pq) Introduction of Ordinances, discussion, and action thereon. (All new Ordinances referred to Committees shall be read, titles only.)
- (qr) Grievance Appeals required by Section 48.09 of this Code.
- (rs) Adjournment.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
