

Interurban Trail Rules

Trails are shared by many users. By respecting the rights of other trail users, the trails will be safe and enjoyable for everyone! Thank you for your cooperation.

- Wear a helmet and appropriate safety gear.
- If you stop, move off the trail.
- Travel on the right. Single file use is preferred.
- Pass on the left, only when safe. Pass only in a single file line.
- When overtaking fellow trail users, warn them by activating a bell, horn, whistle or state that you are "Passing on your left."
- Stop at road crossings and look for traffic.
- Use a reasonable speed (20mph maximum).
- Obey all traffic signs and rules.
- Proceed cautiously when your view might be obstructed.
- Watch for wet or slippery surfaces, sand, rocks, or washouts.
- Dogs should be on a short leash.
- Pickup and dispose of dog and/or other pet droppings, including horses!
- **MOPEDS ARE NOT** allowed on the trail.
- **SNOWMOBILES ARE NOT** allowed on the trail.
- **HUNTING FROM OR ON THE TRAIL RIGHT-OF-WAY** is **NOT** allowed.
