

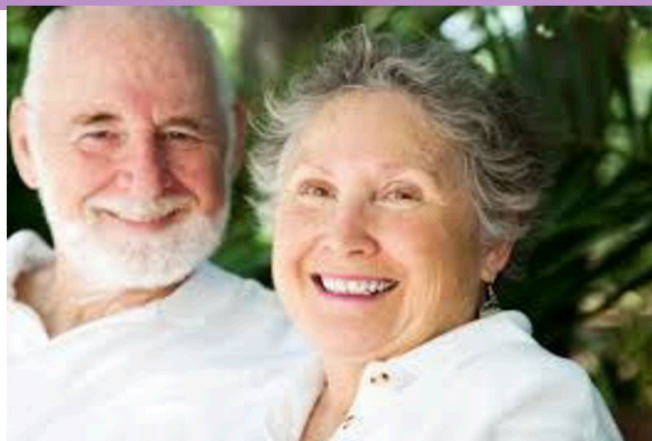
Memory Screening
