Sheboygan County is now offering a Child Car Seat program to Sheboygan County residents. The purpose of our program is to help educate parents, grandparents and foster parents on how to properly install and use car seats. Buckling up the right way on every ride is the single most important thing a family can do to stay safe in the car. When installed and used properly child restraints and seat belts prevent injuries and save lives.

Program Eligibility

- You must be a Sheboygan County Resident
- You must meet the income guidelines (eligible for WIC, Reduced School Lunch Program, BadgerCare, and Foster Parents.)
- If you have a child's car seat and you need it moved to a different location in the vehicle or just want it to be checked for proper installation in the vehicle you are also eligible to come in

Appointments

- An appointment is necessary with the Child Passenger Safety (CPS) Technician for the installation and education of the car seats
